



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

THE SYDNEY COLLEGE OF DIVINITY

and

THE DEPARTMENT OF ANCIENT HISTORY, MACQUARIE UNIVERSITY

The Department of Ancient History in Macquarie University and the Sydney College of Divinity seek to encourage Higher Education in the area of Coptic Studies and support interested students from both institutions.

They agree to do this by increasing the availability of course units related to Coptic Studies through cross-crediting of relevant accredited course units available in each institution.

Students enrolled for a degree in one institution will be allowed cross-credit one or more relevant course units undertaken and completed satisfactorily in the other institution.

This agreement pertains to both undergraduate and postgraduate course units at the appropriate AQF level. The actual units available at either institution will be communicated in advance of enrolment periods and the list of potentially relevant course units will remain open to review and mutual consent to cross-crediting.

It is understood that Sydney College of Divinity course units related to Coptic Studies will normally be delivered by St Cyril's Coptic Orthodox Theological College, but other Member Institutions are included in this agreement as may be relevant.

Students wishing to avail themselves of this opportunity will seek admission to the course units concerned and fulfil other requirements in accordance with the regulations pertaining at the institution delivering those course units.

Both institutions will provide appropriate guidance to their own students.
